

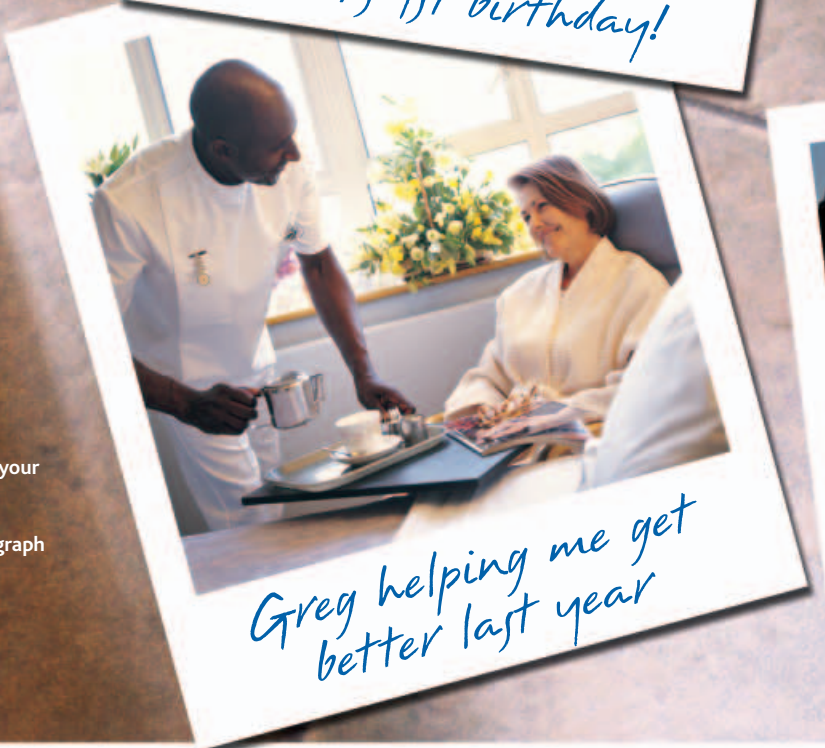

LYMPHOMA SUPPORT IRELAND BEACONS OF HOPE | PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION Marking Worldwide Lymphoma Awareness Day, September 15th 2005

'BEACONS OF HOPE' is an amateur photography competition open to all who wish to symbolise Hope and Survivorship through their photo lens. The competition aims to mark Worldwide Lymphoma Awareness day by encouraging the public, especially those who have been touched by cancer, to represent their 'Beacons of Hope' through the medium of photography.

Deadline for entries is 17th August 2005. The judging panel will include renowned photographer Perry Ogden and Peter Thursfield, Pictures Editor of the Irish Times. Winning entries will be exhibited on Worldwide Lymphoma Awareness day in Dublin, 15th September 2005.

The overall winner will receive €1000 worth of photographic equipment from Spectra Photo. Eleven runners up will receive a Kodak digital camera. All entrants will receive a disposable camera with free processing from Spectra.
